
Teachers and parents can download it and print it to use the content. Children won't be needed any adult supervision to use this content.






Colour the hour clock hand Red, minute clock hand Blue.






Colour the hands of clock that has 8:00








Colour the hands of clock that has 3:00








Colour the hands of clock that has 5:00







Colour the hands of clock that has 11:00

Draw the hands on clock and color them




Cut the clock faces, and glue them to matching times






Write the time shown on each clock




Cut the clock tabes.
